Individuals applying for a scholarship must submit an online application along with supporting documents by July 1, 2022. **Incomplete packets will not be accepted. 2022 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PACKET

1. SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

You're Beautifully Made (YBM) Mentoring Program "Make A Difference" College Scholarship Application will be available on our site at www.yourebeautifullymade.org beginning September 30, 2016. All applications must be typed and submitted along with supporting documents through our website no later than June 1, 2017. Applications will be disqualified if not complete.

2. SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Must be a member of You're Beautifully Made Mentoring Program
- Must be a high school senior
- Must maintain a 3.0 GPA or greater

3. SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- Must submit an online application
- Must maintain a GPA of 3.0 or greater
- Must type and submit a 500-word essay (essay should not exceed 500 words)
- Must complete 30 hours of community service (with YBM and other organizations, businesses, etc)
- Must attend all YBM meetings (unless an emergency arises)
- Must apply to 2-3 colleges and receive at least one acceptance letter from a four year college
- Must obtain a letter of recommendation from a current teacher

4. GPA-3.0 OR GREATER

Applicants MUST maintain a GPA of 3.0 or greater to be eligible for the scholarship. Supporting documentation showing your grades and/or GPA must be included with your application.

5. ESSAY

Applicants are required to submit a 500-word essay. Essays MUST be typed using 12 point, Times New Roman font, and double-spaced. Essays should include the following:

- 1. Describe why you believe you should be the recipient of the scholarship.
- 2. Explain how someone made a difference in your life. Describe how they impacted your decision to attend college.
- 3. Discuss why you want to obtain a college degree. Explain how you plan to utilize what you learned to make a difference in your community.

6. COMMUNITY SERVICE

Applicants are required to complete 30 hours of community service within the time frame of the application process. Community service hours should be completed at one or more an agency that provides services to youth and or families in need. An official letter stating all hours have been completed must be submitted along with your application.

7. LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION

Applicants must submit a letter of recommendation from a current teacher.
